
The Agencia Estatal Consejo Superior de Investigaciones Científicas (CSIC), as the *applicant legal entity*, confirms its intention to support Dr. Elena María García Guerra in the developing of the COST proposal entitled “European monetary unification, from Antiquity to modern times (EMU)”, coordinated by Prof. Georges Depeyrot.

CSIC is concerned with the importance of Euro as a tool to strength a common European identity. In this general context, EMU project will study, as it is considered essential, the particular case of monetary systems of European countries during last centuries, in order to analyze how have they influenced the psychology, consumers’ behaviour, economic references and even the vocabulary of the inhabitants.

The *applicant legal entity* commits itself to:

- a. ensure that the work will be performed under the scientific guidance of the *principal investigator*
- b. carry out the work to be performed, taking into consideration the specific role of the *principal investigator*.
- c. support the *principal investigator* and provide reasonable administrative assistance to the *principal investigator*, in particular as regards:
  - i. the timeliness and clarity of financial information
  - ii. the general management and reporting of finances,
- d. guarantee adequate contractual conditions to the principal investigator, in particular as regards:
  - i. the provisions for annual, sickness and parental leave,
  - ii. occupational health and safety standards,
  - iii. the general social security scheme, such as pension rights.
- e. inform the principal investigator of any circumstances affecting the implementation of the project
